➤ SEFRTOC Statistic

- Helena reviewed historical data for 2009 statistics. She found that the January 2010 stats were double that of January 2009
- The individual agency incidents have been consistent, so Helena concluded the increase was due to addition of MDX and I-595 Express to the group.
- Joe Snyder inquired regarding specific trends for interagency incidents for District VI; Helena could not identify any.

➤ 511/FLATIS

- No current information regarding 511/FLATIS upgrades
- The group discussed creating a protocol in which the SEFRTOC members contact each other if no Spanish speaking operator is available for a specific TMC. Current statewide protocol states to contact District 2 if a Spanish speaking operator is required. The creation of a SEFRTOC Spanish speaking operator list will enable the members to stay within the region. If the list is exhausted then the affected TMC will contact District 2.
- Joe Snyder will discuss with the 511/FLATIS group if there is a problem with changing the protocol. Joe will also look into who is the lead regarding statewide floodgate alerts.



➤ Superbowl Updates

- Kelly reported that the majority of the Superbowl traffic came from Miami. The delays were mainly at the northbound 199 St ramp with delays over the flyover. After some delay the situation was resolved by FHP. There were 2 hours delays after the game that were from the stadium to the Golden Glades
- Joe Snyder reported that there were northbound I-95 delays due to the shutdown of the general purpose lanes for the escort of the buses from the express lanes. Additionally, ramp signaling was operated to help with the flow of traffic.
- Bob Murphy inquired regarding the portable VMS signs around the stadium and the previous Superbowl problems. Kelly stated that this time there was a crew that was very responsive to make changes to the portable signs to ensure that they were reflected of the large overhead signs. This reflects a successful recommend change from the SEFRTOC committee from the previous Superbowl.

➤ Other Updates

- Group discussed adjusting the SEFRTOC VIP motorcade protocol. Upon full approval, the protocol will include VIP Motorcade event activity which will be designated as Police Activity in SunGuide. Partial or rolling closures due to VIP activity or special event will be monitored. If congestion results from the rolling closures, Congestion event will be entered into SunGuide.

➤ Partner Updates

- Florida Turnpike TMC
 - Kelly stated the Turnpike will be closed for the construction of the Florida gas line transmission between Commercial Blvd and Okeechobee Blvd on Saturday, Feb 27th, from 12am to 4am.
- MDX TMC
 - Jerry stated that from Saturday Feb 20th at 10am to Monday Feb 22nd at 4am, the entire length of SR 924 will be closed in both directions for ORT installation. District IV and VI will assist with DMS messaging.
