 - Florida's Turnpike One Way Evacuation Plan (OWE)

There are 4 potential evac routes from South Florida (Florida's Turnpike, US 27, I-95 & I-75)
 Tasked to come up with plans; following are some notes from presentation by Doug Prager:
 Maximize existing lanes

- Prevention, toll suspension, etc. (counter-productive to suspend SB tolls)
- Keys Evacuation from HEFT
- Expanded Roar Ranger Coverage
- Fuel (manned by facilities) used to back-up RR
- Wrecker Plan
- Stranded motorist plan
- In TX there were an average of 40 vehicles stuck per mile
- Small coach to service plaza – larger buses to remove from system (note, once you move people you are responsible)

US 1 Palm Drive Plan:

- Choke point from Palm Drive to Turnpike
- Increased green time NB on 344th/Palm

ITS Role:

- Safety, early detection, proper dispatch, command/control, notification, safety

OWE:

Primary 88 to 270

Contingency: 0 to 270

When:

Cat 4 with Governor direction, potential @ 3rd or 4th storm, will be assessed by storm

GG to 270 is off table due to construction.

0 to 270: long set up time (longer than any storm has allowed in the past)

Loss of equipment in previous storms

Can't interfere with coastal evac by clogging arterials
