#### ➤ SEFRTOC Statistic

Helena reported that although the interagency incidents remain the same overall, there was an increased in the number of interagency incidents for District VI. This may be the result of increased construction on SR 874 and the SR 826/836 project.

#### ➤ 511/FLATIS

- Dee discussed that the 511/FLATIS data archives is in testing. Joe Snyder added that if you set the subscriber and then reset the subscriber, it will cause system to crash.
- Dee also discussed some upcoming changes to the map being much more detailed and Google like. Operators can set up different views using a drop down list.

#### ➤ Hurricane Preparedness Updates

- Bob Murphy stated the planned meeting with FHP Troop L has not occurred yet.
- All the partners except PB have emergency response plans. Palm Beach emergency response plan is still being developed.

#### ➤ Partner Updates

- District IV TMC
  - Two Road Ranges involved in accidents, no serious injuries involved.



- District VI TMC
  - Joe Snyder discussed some recent RISC events. Additionally, there is a plan to have a mock up RISC event that will help educate responders.

➤ **SEFRTOC workshop discussion:**

- DMS messaging:
  - District IV TMC
    - Display “SLOW TRAFFIC AHEAD”, if there is congestion ahead using closes DMS sign in advance of congestion
    - Display messages related to Move Over Law when there are emergency responders on the shoulder; “ROAD RANGER AHEAD” “MOVE OVER”
    - Display weather related incidents, such as fog, tornado, severe weather alerts
    - Display PSA
    - Display “TRAFFIC MUST EXIT” for full main line closures
    - Display regional messaging based on their SOG
  - District VI TMC
    - Display travel lane blocked messages (including debris within 5 miles of blockage)
    - Display different travel lane blocked messages for express and general purpose lanes
    - Display congestion messages for the Keys and US-1
    - Display weather related messages
    - Display PSA
    - Display regional messaging based on their SOG
  - 595 Express TMC
    - Display messages similar to District IV TMC
    - Display regional message for District IV and Florida’s Turnpike



- Palm Beach TMC
    - Display congestion with delay messages
    - No PSA displayed
  - Florida's Turnpike TMC
    - Display travel lanes
    - Display shoulder blocked events with delays
    - Display "SLOW TRAFFIC AHEAD"
    - Display "DELAYS AHEAD" from exit to exit
  - MDX TMC
    - Display travel lane blockage using Road Ranger DMS boards
    - Display "CAUTION MDX ROAD RANGER" for Road Ranger shoulder events
  - FLATIS Congestion Reporting
    - District IV, District VI, MDX and 595 report congestion in the same manner
    - District VI and MDX regularly review FLATIS calls. The other partners do sporadic checking
