#### ➤ SEFRTOC Stats

- December 2009 stats reviewed. Helena is currently working on year end review of 2009 statistics. Although it is incomplete, she has seen an increase in DMS activation and interagency incident due to the addition of I-595 to the SEFRTOC group.
- Helena suggested that an interagency incident be review at the next meeting with the group.
- Helena requires an updated number of partner DMS devices.

#### ➤ 511/FLATIS

- Kelly stated that FTE is not connected to 511/FLATIS though SunGuide due to a required server upgrades. This prevents them find sending out Floodgate and Banner messages though 511/FLATIS. Currently D4 is providing the Floodgate and Banners for FTE. New servers have been purchased and will be reconnected in the near future.
- Joe stated that 511/FLATIS currently getting an upgrade regarding IVR and congestion.

#### ➤ VIP/Police Activity Event Type Management

- Alex Mirones reviewed the VIP/Police Activity event type protocol that he had submitted. The group agreed that the use of Police Activity as an event type was appropriate for VIP. The event type will be created in SunGuide for full closures, not for rolling closures
- There were questions regarding rolling closure and how to handle the related congestion. It was suggested that a congestion event be created or a Floodgate message be activated relaying the



information regarding the delays. Joe suggested a draft be created clarifying the parameters regarding rolling closures.

### ➤ **Superbowl Updates**

- Joe Snyder stated at last Superbowl meeting that they discussed the parking layout. There is a scheduled meeting on Thursday January 21 with the hope there is a discussion regarding the messaging plan. Joe Snyder expressed some concern regarding messaging and not having VMS on their right-of-way. A plan had been submitted, awaiting approval
- Joe Snyder suggested a tele-conference to discuss the Pro-Bowl plans. In addition a post Pro-Bowl tele-conference to discuss the do's and don'ts prior to the Super-Bowl.
- Joe Snyder and Kelly Kinney will be posted at the Traffic Command post. Mike Washburn will be posted at the Security Command post.

### ➤ **Partner Updates**

- District VI SunGuide TMC
  - Joe stated began tolling on the SB I-95 HOT lanes on January 15<sup>th</sup> and all is going well.
- Florida Turnpike TMC
  - Kelly stated the Turnpike will be closed for the construction of the Florida gas line transmission between Southern Blvd and Jupiter on Thursday, Jan 21, from 12am to 4am.
- District 1 TMC
  - Carlos stated that the District 1 TMC went live on Tuesday, Jan 19. The center is now a fully operational 24/7 center.

- RISC
  - Javier discussed a recent RISC event and wanted input on how the partners handled late arrival of resources of the RISC vendor. The group agreed that unless that were circumstances beyond the RISC vendor control such as; no shoulder, construction zone with no easy access, there would not be any bonus for late arrival
