#### ➤ SEFRTOC Statistic

- Helena reviewed the current statistics. She found that the January and February 2010 stats were pretty consistent; 203 interagency incident for January and 200 interagency incidents for February.

#### ➤ 511/FLATIS

- No current information regarding 511/FLATIS upgrades
- Jerry discussed a recent email that was sent on the SEFRTOC group behalf to District Headquarters regarding the proposed protocol permitting each partner contact each other regarding Spanish speaking Floodgate message/banner before proceeding to District 2.

#### ➤ Hurricane Preparedness Updates

- Bob Murphy reported that FHP-Davie is in the process of kicking off this spring a table-top demonstration and or a one-way evacuation drill.
- Dee McTague reported that in April that she will be involved a Web EOC that will train the trainer. Bob Murphy added that the Web EOC is a internet accessible program that has multiple applications that allows the user to access and input data related to Hurricane related incidents
- Kelly Kinney reported that FTE had their first one-way training session. The current evacuation plan has the cross over at the Lantana Toll Plaza with the terminus at MM 254. An additional evacuation plan has the almost the entire length of the Turnpike covered from MM 0 to South of



Orlando. On-site district training will take place for District IV and VI personal who would assist at the interchanges in the event of a one-way evacuation. The next SERFTOC meeting, Kelly suggested she will have the one-way evacuation presentation.

➤ **SR 826-836 Reconstruction Project Update**

- Jerry Cosme reported that construction has begun on SR 826 and SR 836 interchange. The 5 year construction will involve the widening of both roadways that will include the construction of a four-level interchange. Additional Road Rangers are available in the construction area that is dispatched from District VI. If Road Rangers are required on SR 836, MDX TMC will coordinate with District VI TMC to have the Road Ranger respond.

➤ **Partner Updates**

- SWIFT SunGuide TMC
  - John Scarpellino spoke about the SWIFT SunGuide TMC going operational as of January 19, 2010.
  - John and Carlos Bonilla spoke that the SWIFT SunGuide will be assuming 511 responsibilities as of April 12<sup>th</sup>. They will use scanner transmission to populate 511 with information regarding Collier, Lee, Sarasota, and Polk and Manatee counties.
  - SWIFT SunGuide has 79 CCTV, 26 DMS, over 100 radar detectors covering I-75 and US-41. Additionally there is a cable barrier system on I-75 that is capable of sending out an alarm and a beacon light that notifies the TMC and FHP if a section of the fence along Alligator Alley is hit because of a vehicle. This will allow for quick responses to any breaches along the fence line.
  - Current protocol for notification for incidents on Alligator Alley between District 1 and District VI requires notification for all level incidents. Additionally notification may be necessary due to the single lane reconstruction along US-41. Dee will provide the name and number of the EIC to District 1.
- I-595 Express TMC
  - Catherine Werner stated currently construction is a SR 84 and Pine Island Road and will be moving onto I-595 shortly. I-595 Express TMC will be handling events at the I-595 and Florida's Turnpike Interchange.
- Florida's Turnpike TMC
  - Kelly reported that both direction of the Turnpike will be closed on April 8<sup>th</sup> from the Golden Glades to I-595.
- District IV TMC
  - Bob reported that recently they had their third RISC event on the ramp from eastbound I-595 to northbound I-95. The incident involved a pick-up towing a box trailer that lasted from 1:30pm to 3:00pm. A Post Incident Analysis (PIA) meeting will occur at the District IV to review the incident.
