

SIRV Status Report for April 2006

Incident Data Review

SIRV has responded to 32 incidents in the month of May and has provided assistance on 30 of the 32 incidents. SIRV was able to reduce incident durations and reduce lane closure durations on 10 incidents.

- Incident Duration Reduction Time = 180 Minutes
- Total Lane Closure Reduction Time = 242 Minutes

Agency Time Saving Report

SIRV was able to reduce agency resources on scene as follows:

- Road Rangers = 45 Minutes
- FDOT Maintenance = 215 Minutes
- FHP = 30 Minutes
- Fire = 5 Minutes
- Tow Company = 80 Minutes

Total Agency Time Saved = 375 Minutes

Total Time Saved = 797 Minutes
