



## Monthly Report for March 2009

### Incident Data Review

SIRV has responded to 54 incidents in the month of March and has provided assistance on 33 of the incidents. SIRV was able to reduce incident duration and reduce lane closure duration on 20 of the incidents.

- Incident Duration Reduction Time = 183 Minutes
- Total Lane Closure Reduction Time = 329 Minutes

### Agency Time Saving Report

SIRV was able to reduce agency resources on scene as follows:

- Road Rangers = 598 Minutes
- Fire Department = 330 Minutes
- Maintenance = 70 Minutes
- Law Enforcement = 492 Minutes
- Tow Company = 70 Minutes

Total Agency Time Saved = 1,560 Minutes

**Total Time Saved = 2,072 Minutes**
