Toys in the Sun Run – Mike McGee

On December 9, 2007 there was the annual Toy Run that was held. There were some problems on the interstate, north of the parade route that resulted in contra-flow issues. These issues are being addressed with Broward Sheriffs Office in preparation for next years' event

I-595 Managed Lanes – Bob Murphy/Mike McGee

There have been some concerns with the fire departments and the barrier walls that are going to be installed in this project. Below are some concerns:

- How often will the barriers have breaks placed along the walls?
- Will the breaks accommodate other agencies apparatus sizes?
- Are there any water main access points to retrieve water for fires?

Concerns to follow up on with fire agencies:

- Sizes of various apparatuses that would access 595 managed lanes
- Allow for U-turns to get to incidents on opposite sides.
- 42' is not large enough to accommodate U-turns

Bob mentioned that the elevated lanes are now at-grade level and are no longer elevated lanes. Ian Beavia of RS&H can be contacted for questions or concerns.

Wildfire Season – Scott Peterich – Division of Forestry

Scott stated that their meteorologist has reported that this wildfire season is drier than normal and showed a map of the fires that have occurred in 2006-07. Mike stated that the self assessment will have some minor changes and that the process of how we evaluate ourselves will be less bothersome than prior years. This year the TIM Management team will do the assessment and will seek the attention of the group for the assessment of the Operational Phase which is Section 4.2. The group will break up into smaller groups during the March meeting.

Statewide TIM

- **RISC Workshop Update**
 - A meeting was held on December 19, 2007 at the Deerfield Beach Fire Rescue Station. In that meeting it was discussed what the draft scope should consist of. There were many items to be followed up on for the TIM Management team.
 - A major factor of RISC that has been an issue is Rule 15b of the Florida Administrative Code.

Southeast Florida Regional Transportation Operations Committee Update – Bob Murphy

The Dynamic Message Sign (DMS) policy of signing for other counties is being modified to so that messaging can be done for other agencies properly when more than one county is involved.



The SEFRTOC Standard Operating Guidelines is currently being updated. The state will be deploying a new version of the SunGuide software that we use to track incidents at the TMC.

511 Update – Mike Millard

- A monthly evaluation on accuracy with area transportation management centers and 511 was conducted and over the course of 2 years the accuracy is up to 98%.

Post Incident Analysis Review – Tom Dickson/David Soto

David Soto of Florida's Turnpike reviewed an incident involving a tanker rollover on October 30, 2007 on I-595 NB entrance ramp to Florida's Turnpike. Please see attached debriefing.

Tom reviewed the bus crash that happened on January 5, 2008 on I-595 EB ramp to Florida's Turnpike. All agencies worked well with one another and there were no major issues that came about from this incident.
